## Residential Conservation Landscaping Maintenance Schedule and Guidelines

## First Year Maintenance Guidelines

Successful establishment of conservation landscaped areas requires that the following tasks be undertaken in the first year following installation:

- Watering. Watering is needed once a week during the first 2 months, and then as needed during first growing season (April-October), depending on rainfall.
- Remove and replace dead plants.


## Routine Maintenance Guidelines

Conservation landscaped areas must be inspected to ensure good health of plants.

| Routine Maintenance Tasks | Frequency |
| :--- | :--- |
| Remove trash and debris | As needed |
| Check and repair eroded areas | Annually |
| Weed mulch | Twice during the growing season |
| Inspect plant composition for consistency with <br> approved plans and correct any deficiencies | Annually |
| Remulch to maintain a 2-3 inch layer | Annually |
| Prune trees and shrubs | Annually |
| Remove invasive plants | As needed |
| Replace dead or damaged plant material | As needed |
