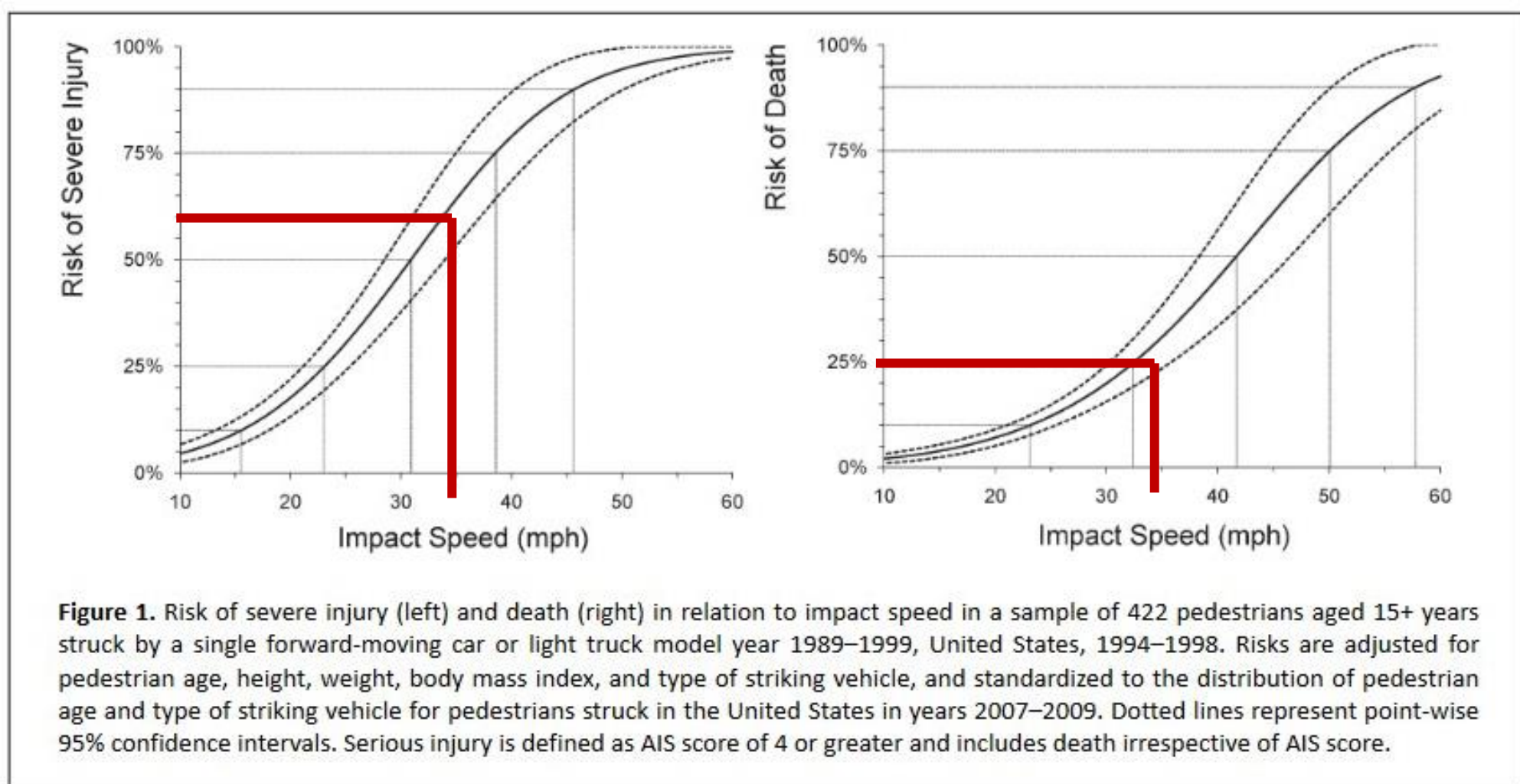

Speed Study Results April 12th – April 19th

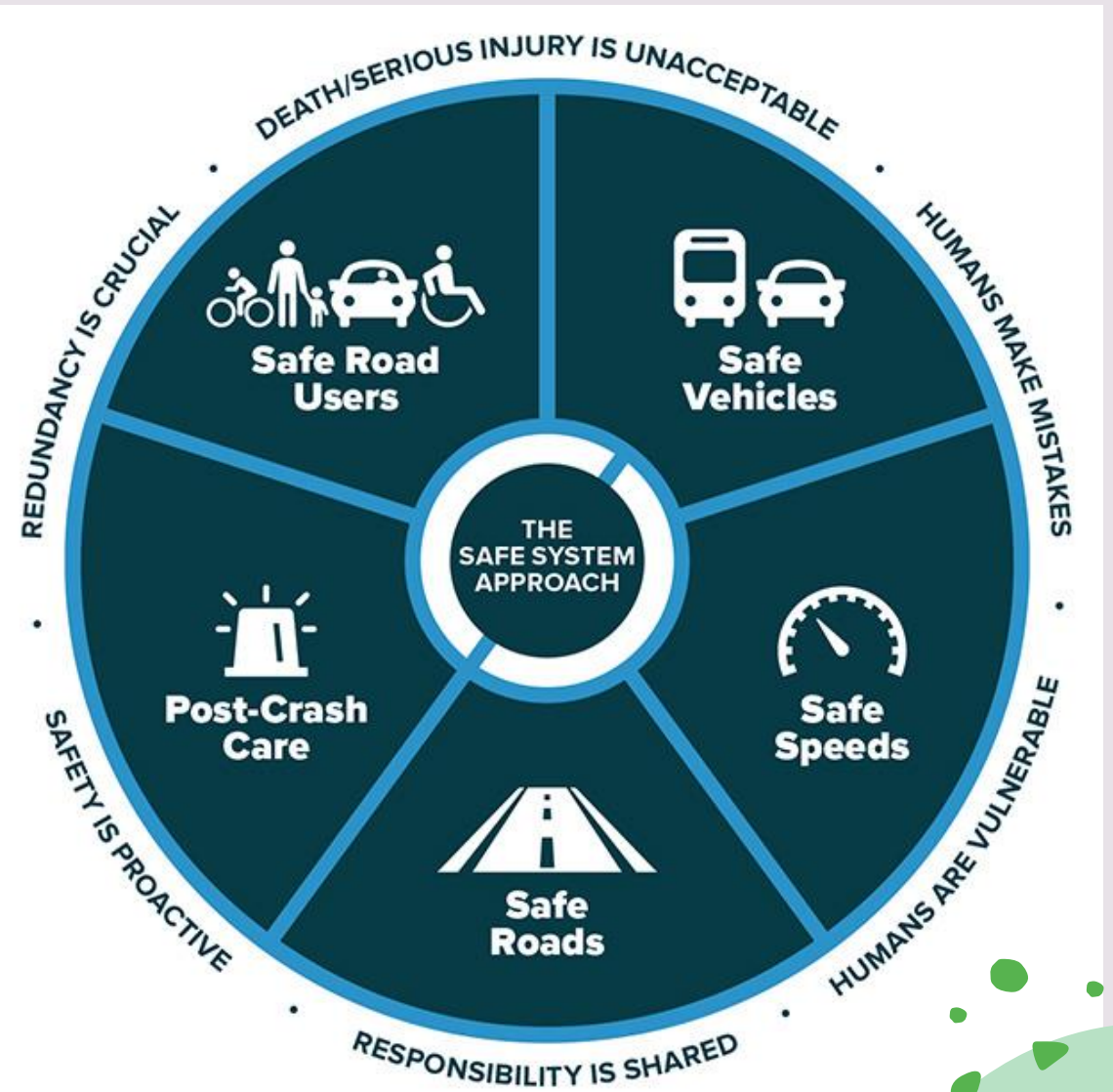
Between 7:00am and 4:00pm (Posted Speed Limit is 25MPH)

- **22,319 drivers going 37-49 MPH**
- **597 drivers going over 50 MPH**
- **11 drivers going over 60 MPH**
