Team Up to Slow Down Yard Sign Usage Policy

Yard Signs will be given to neighborhoods participating in Team Up to Slow Down. These yard signs say slogans that remind drivers to slow down in neighborhoods and show drivers that you care. Yard signs may also help further raise awareness about the dangers of speeding.

Team Up to Slow Down Yard Sign Usage Policy:

- Yard signs are made available at no cost to neighbors that have 4 or more households on a street participating in Team Up to Slow Down.
- The signs will be picked up by a neighbor from the Harrisonburg Public Works Department. The neighbor who picks up the signs is responsible for distributing the other yard signs to the rest of the neighbors and for returning the signs.
- Yard signs are to be kept for a maximum of 6-8 weeks. Afterward, the signs are to be returned to the Harrisonburg Public Works Department.
- A changing display of signs is more effective than a constant display of safe driving signs. Therefore, neighborhoods can ask to use the signs for another 6-8 week period, 8 weeks after returning the signs.
- Signs must be placed so that they do not block sight distance.
- Signs must be on private property. It is recommended to keep signs about 10 feet from the roadway and 2 feet from the sidewalk.
