2024 CITIZEN ACADEMY

The Harrisonburg Citizen Academy is a 13-week program comprised of one 2-hour session per week designed to teach residents about the City and the services it provides. Participants will hear from different departments on their daily operations in a hands-on learning environment. This program will be held on Thursday evenings (*with three exceptions - see the 2024 Schedule for more*) from 6 to 8 p.m. and runs each fall. Some classes may extend past two hours depending on content, and there is one optional Saturday class.
