

# AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT (ARPA) **APPROVED SPENDING PLAN**



The City of Harrisonburg has allocated its State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds from the American Rescue Plan to twenty different projects in six different categories, totaling more than \$23,800,000.
