## **Local Government:**

- i. Type of Government Harrisonburg is an independent City that operates under the Council/City Manager form of Government.
- ii. Sources of revenue; taxation Like most local governments in Virginia, Harrisonburg's largest revenue source is real estate taxes. Personal property taxes, retail sales taxes, meals tax revenues, and lodging tax revenues are also major contributors to the City's general fund.
- iii. Current plans affecting the study area, such as comprehensive plans, area plans, school system plans, capital improvement programs, etc. Attached you will find Golf Course Site Plan, Heritage Oaks Golf Course Master Plan, Heritage Oaks Environmental Management Plan, and the Driving Range, Grassing, Irrigation, Planting Plans and the recent Heritage Oaks Golf Course Analysis conducted by Golf Business Advisors completed in April 2021.
