City Recruits for the Next Police Chief of HPD

Harrisonburg, Va. – The city of Harrisonburg is in the process of recruiting the next chief of the Harrisonburg Police Department.

In partnership with The Novak Consulting Group, the position of police chief is open for recruitment and resumes are now being accepted.

The Novak Consulting Group was selected to assist with this recruitment and has hosted focus groups, surveyed the community, met with staff of the Harrisonburg Police Department, and communicated with the city’s administration and City Council.

“We wanted to get input from our staff and from members of the community on what their vision for our next police chief would be,” explained City Manager Eric Campbell.

With that information, a profile was developed and the recruitment materials are being distributed throughout the United States.

“This will be a broad search to ensure we get the best fit for our police department and community,” said Campbell.

The goal is to have the next police chief hired by July 2018.
