City Planning Commission Meetings Now Broadcast Live

Harrisonburg, Va. – The city of Harrisonburg’s Planning Commission will now broadcast its meetings live on television and online.

The Harrisonburg Planning Commission meeting that will be held on Wednesday, August 8 at 7:00 p.m. will be aired on the local public education government channel 3 or by visiting www.HarrisonburgVA.gov/planning-commission.

“This is another opportunity for the city to engage and involve our residents in their local government,” explained Thanh Dang, city planner with the Planning and Community Development Department.

The Planning Commission is comprised of seven city residents, one of which is a member on Harrisonburg City Council. These members serve four-year terms and have a two-term maximum they are able to serve. They typically meet every second Wednesday of the month to consider requests from citizens and developers on issues such as rezoning requests, special use permits, major subdivisions, and street and alley closings.

The commission’s recommendations are then forwarded to City Council.
