Disruption in Water Service and Street Improvements

Harrisonburg, Va. – The Public Utilities Department will be working to repair a water service on Old South High Street beginning at 8:00 a.m. on Tuesday, October 2. This work will cause a temporary interruption to service for customers residing from 207 to 322 Old South High. The street will remain open while the work is conducted and water service should return by early afternoon.

Two street projects may cause some minor disruptions during the remainder of the week of October 1. First, beginning at 8:00 p.m. on Wednesday, October 3 contractors will be milling and paving portions of road at the intersection of Bluestone Avenue and South Main Street. Little disruption to traffic is anticipated, but there will be temporary lane closures in both directions along Main Street, at this intersection.

Second, beginning at 8:00 a.m. on Friday, October 5 there will be temporary lane closures along Martin Luther King, Jr. Way bridge to accommodate routine inspections.

The **Harrisonburg Department of Public Utilities** is responsible for providing water and sewer services to residences and businesses. The Department currently manages approximately 16,000 accounts.
