City seeks to fill multiple part-time positions at Feb. 25 job fair

HARRISONBURG, Va. – The City of Harrisonburg and the Department of Parks and Recreation will look to bolster their ranks of part-time staff members with a job fair later this month.

The event, on Tuesday, Feb. 25, from 3 to 8 p.m. at the Lucy F. Simms Continuing Education Center, will look to hire multiple seasonal part-time positions for Parks and Recreation, as well as a limited number of positions for the Department of Public Works. Applicants will be able to apply on-site and get the chance to speak directly with their potential employers.

The City annually employs more than 130 part-time and temporary staff members, who are a vital part of providing City services to residents and visitors to the area. Positions available at this year's job fair include maintenance positions at Heritage Oaks Golf Course and at City parks, recreation aides, lifeguards, mowing crew and more.
