Crosswalk work will bring lane closures to Main, East Market streets

HARRISONBURG, Va. – Crosswalk improvements will briefly close lanes in Downtown next week on Main and East Market streets.

Crews will install stamped asphalt crosswalks at the intersection of Main and East Market streets, and the crosswalks will match others throughout the Downtown area. They should be completed in two days, weatherpermitting.

The work is scheduled to take place Tuesday, June 9, on Main Street, and Wednesday, June 10, on East Market Street. Tuesday's work will require some lane closures on Main Street from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Wednesday's work will require East Market Street to be closed completely from Main Street to Mason Street from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m., and detour signage will be put in place.

Drivers are urged to use caution in this area while work takes place.



The stamped asphalt crosswalks will be added at the intersection of Main and East Market streets (above). Once finished, the crosswalks will look like others located throughout Harrisonburg's Downtown (right). Installation will take place on Tuesday and Wednesday, weather-permitting.
