Traffic pattern change starts Tuesday at MLK Way and South Main

HARRISONBURG, Va. – Crews will work to make a lane change during the early morning hours on Tuesday, Aug. 25, on westbound Martin Luther King, Jr. Way at South Main Street.

The center westbound lane of Martin Luther King, Jr. Way will be changed to a straight-thru traffic only lane beginning Tuesday. Drivers currently have the option of going straight or turning left onto South Main Street from that lane.

The change is being made to improve the traffic flow in the area. Signage will be in place on Martin Luther King, Jr. Way to warn drivers of the change.

Please use caution in this area as drivers become accustomed to the traffic change.
