## Harrisonburg Fire Department seeks public's help after structure fire

HARRISONBURG, Va. – The Harrisonburg Fire Department is seeking the public's help in providing any information relating to a structure fire that occurred in a multi-family apartment unit over the weekend.

Firefighters responded for a reported structure fire at 60-66 Pleasant Hill Road on Sunday, Nov. 21, at approximately 4:45 p.m. Firefighters found active fire inside the structure and smoke throughout upon arrival, and were able to quickly contain the damage, which has been set at \$30,000. Multiple residents were displaced due to the incident.



Although no residents or firefighters were injured, HFD is asking for assistance in determining a cause. The Fire Marshal's Office is

currently investigating and is seeking the public's help in providing any information relating to this fire.
