


On October 3, 2023, the Harrisonburg Police Department discovered that a robbery suspect was barricaded in the 600 block of Liberty Street. This information was provided by his mother who also reported that she was just assaulted by him.

Several HPD officers, SWAT Team members, CNT and Command Officers responded to the scene. After a short while it was decided that we needed the Drone Team, the Mobile Command Post, and medical personnel to standby. Not long after our request was made to your team, did they arrive- and boy did they! There were more HFD Personnel on site than police!

Why was this so important? Because HPD Command could focus on the critical incident at hand and HFD Personnel could handle all the logistics, computers, drones, and robots. It was especially helpful to have Deputy Chief Zimmerman present to check in every so often with me to see if we needed anything.

I am pleased to report that after 8+ hours the situation was resolved, and the suspect was taken into custody without incident.

Thank you for your commitment to teamwork and continued cooperation. Please extend my gratitude to your personnel who assisted my team on October 3, 2023.


